#### Unstable Weather conditions forecast for Sunday and Monday

*St. George's, Grenada – Saturday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024. 9:30 p.m.*

The Meteorological Office has advised the National Disaster Management Agency (NaDMA) that unstable weather conditions are forecast for the Southern Caribbean within the next 12 to 48 hours. This is due to the expected interaction of moisture from the ITCZ and a frontal system with support from a trough.

Showers and thundershowers are expected on Sunday November 17, and Monday 18. If the conditions persist, a low chance of flooding and landslides can be expected on Monday.

Citizens are urged to be vigilant, monitor the weather conditions, and pay attention to the information issued by the Meteorological Office and NaDMA.

NaDMA and the Meteorological Office will continue to monitor the situation and provide updates as necessary.
