Weather Condition	Hurricane conditions experienced throughout the State on Monday, July 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2024. More severe impacts in Carriacou and Petite Martinique.

NEOC Status	Currently Activated
Law Enforcement	Royal Grenada Police Force and His Majesty's prison activated their emergency plans. There are reports of damage to some police stations.
Water	Island wide system shutdown.
Electricity	Island wide system shutdown.
Sea Ports/Airports	Airports and seaports are closed.
Customs	To be assessed
Welfare/Social Services	To be assessed
Health Services	There are reports of damage to the roof of the Psychiatric Hospital.
Emergency Shelters	77 Emergency Shelters are activated. 3,057 people in Shelters. (Numbers may fluctuate sharply)
Education	Schools are currently closed.
Transport/Road Clearance	To be assessed
Special area of focus	Carriacou and Petite Martinique have been severely impacted. Initial reports suggest significant damage to the housing stock.
